Recycled content

Milliken & Company continues to research and develop opportunities to increase the recycled content in our products. Our newest patent-pending underbody shield contains 60% recycled content while still featuring enhanced rigidity, extreme durability and superior acoustics.



Safety

Safety has always been Milliken & Company's number one priority. Our facilities are Voluntary Protection Program (VPP) certified, ensuring we go above and beyond OSHA requirements by maintaining injury rates below national averages. All safety incidents are reviewed in detail to determine countermeasures and prevent recurring accidents.



ISO certified

All automotive textile plants are ISO 14001:2015 certified and therefore required to manage environmental responsibilities in a systematic manner. Our Hillcrest, Silao and Gillespie manufacturing sites diligently create solutions to reduce the risk of environmental impacts.



Zero waste to landfill

Milliken & Company set a goal to eliminate all waste to landfill by 2025. Our Hillcrest plant sends polyester waste to a third-party firm to mechanically recycle plant scrap into usable fiber for new nonwoven boards. In 2021, over 25 tons of plant scrap were converted.
